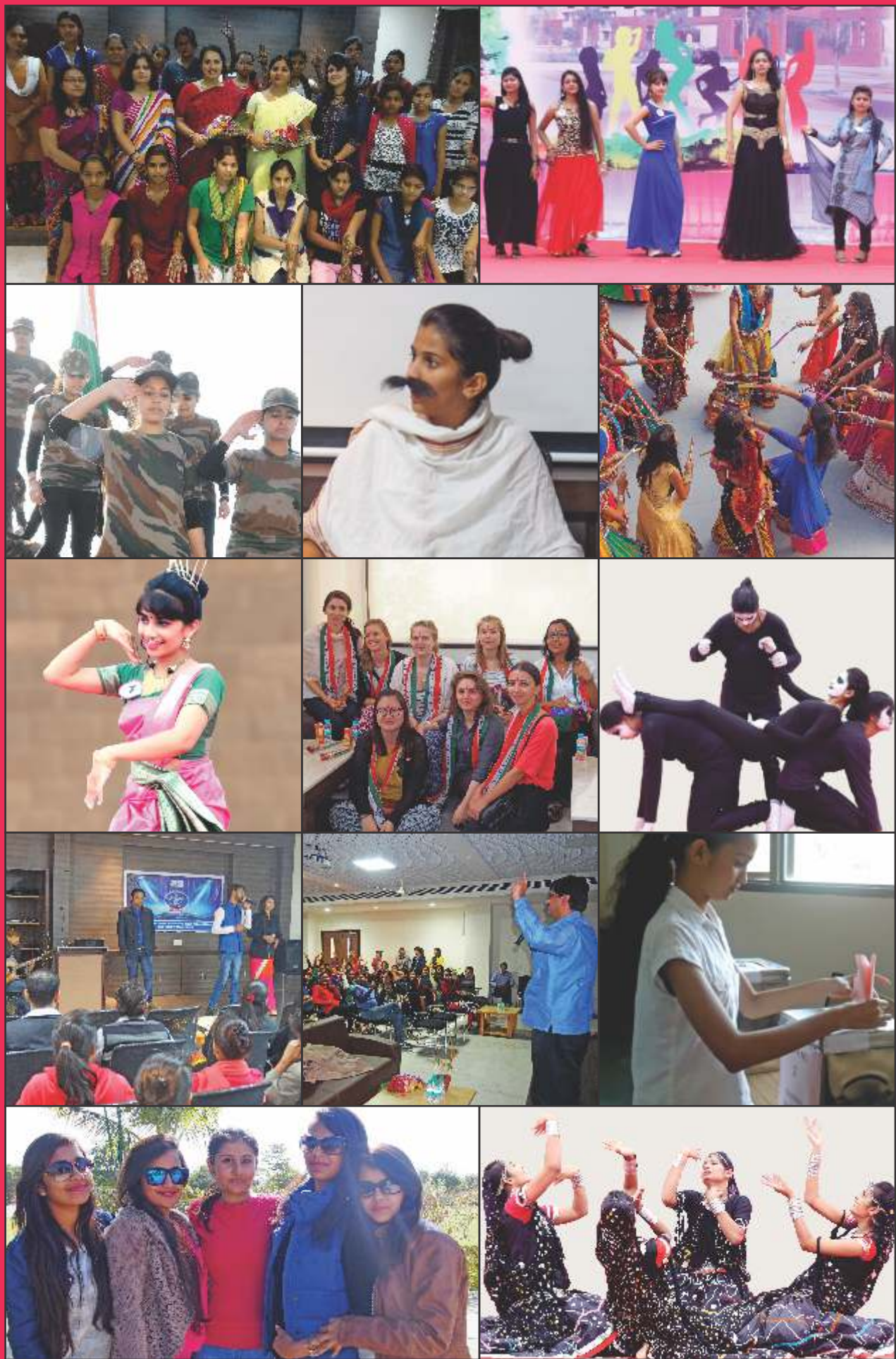

ATTENDANCE RULES
