














प्रिय विद्यार्थियों,




THE JOURNEY

Expanding Horizons

Smart Classrooms: We have smart learning spaces with sophisticated software, interactive modules, smartboards, and audiovisual aids. Smart Classroom provides advanced tools for faculty to incorporate a wide range of media in instruction and to enrich student learning experience.

E-Governance through ERP System: We are amongst the forerunner institutions in Rajasthan to have adapted an ERP platform; it is an information-driven electronic interface connecting management, faculty, students and parents. The ERP system enables seamless interaction across the campus in a lucid, transparent and time-efficient manner; thereby promoting personalized educational experience.

Laboratories: To impart practical exposure, improve understanding and grasp scientific principles better, the college has well equipped labs for all disciplines in conventional Sciences, Computer Technology, Food and Nutrition, Textile Technology, Psychology and Geography.

Library: The college maintains a well-stocked library which boasts of a rich collection of more than 20,100 books; further additions to titles and volumes are underway. Our e-library also substantially complements the printed reference section.

Student Security: Our prime concern at SRKPGC is to ensure zero tolerance towards any lapse on the safety front. Tight security network through CCTV cameras, biometric attendance and attendance notifications sent to the parents are checkpoints to ensure safety of our students.

Transport Facility: It is an optional service offered by the college for the convenience and easy commute of the students. Pre-Admission Counselling: The prospective students can take Aptitude Test conducted by the college prior to admissions. This test provides information to the students regarding career options available to them based on their interests, subject knowledge and aptitude profile. IIRS: Our college is now a network institute of IIRS Outreach Programme by the Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS, ISRO), Dehradun. Till date, we have hosted 21st, 22nd, and 23rd Outreach Programme in our campus

Skill Based Programmes: The set of Skill Based Programmes that we offer at our college aims at practical learning and professional knowledge to deliver systematic training and vocational skills.

Guidance for Competitive Exams: We, not only, award degrees to our students; but also prepare them for competitive exams like CAT/ MAT, CA-CPT, RAS/ IAS, SSC, Bank PO/ Clerk and other govt. exams.



RKCL Centre: Our college is the centre for Rajasthan Knowledge Corporation Limited (RKCL), authorized to conduct RS-CIT - a high quality and low cost IT literacy programme. The training is provided in our sophisticated computer labs by a well qualified and experienced faculty.

Industrial Training: To apply classroom theories to the real world job situations, we provide industrial exposure through obligatory industrial training. The students must undertake training for 2 weeks or more at an industry of their choice.



NGO Internship: The students at our college have to undergo mandatory internship at an NGO for a minimum duration of 2 weeks. These internships create and sustain opportunities for meaningful engagements with the society through thoughtful actions.

National Service Scheme: The college has a proactive NSS unit of 100 volunteers, which aims to orient the youth towards selfless volunteerism and community services. Anti-Ragging Cell: The college has a dedicated Anti-Ragging Cell which works in accordance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The committee has been constituted to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the bane of ragging. Any incidence of ragging must be reported to the Anti-Ragging Cell. Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell: It is established as per the guidelines of UGC and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to provide a safe, secure and congenial atmosphere to the staff and the students. Its objective is to combat the scourge of sexual harassment and integrate the guidelines against it for an impartial institutional policy.

AISHE Cell: The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) has endeavoured to conduct an annual web-based All India Survey on Higher Education (AISHE) to document the status of Higher Education in the country. The college has constituted this cell, which compiles and uploads reliable and comprehensive institutional data to the AISHE web portal.

Research Promotion Committee: The college has set up this committee to promote research projects and activities on the campus. The committee encourages faculty members and students to keep themselves abreast on recent advancements in their respective field.

Grievance Redressal Cell: This cell is empowered to address the genuine complaints and grievances of the students and the staff. They are encouraged to use Suggestion Box placed in the campus to express their issues and problems. The cell commits to provide hassle free grievance redressal.

Training and Placement Cell: The cell intends to counsel students regarding academic programmes for further education, various competitive exams, and employment opportunities in different sectors. Additionally, this cell strives to facilitate the process for summer internships and campus placements for the students, and plans to organize campus drives in the college.



Tech Club: The club offers a platform to explore student's latent talents in a collaborative learning environment; enabling them to come up with innovative ideas. The members learn graphic designing and image editing using CorelDRAW and Photoshop and contribute to the designing of college publications. This club also conducts engaging talks on recent IT trends and dynamic workshops on new technologies.



 Students should compulsorily wear the prescribed college uniform on all working days; except on Thursday.




- Students must attend the regular Assembly programmes as well as special functions organised by the college.









































OUR STAR ACHIEVERS
