WONDER HERTZ 2016

"NEVER STOP QUESTIONING"

The great and humble scientist Albert Einstein once remarked, "The important thing is to never stop questioning." Going by the same dictum, a two-day Science Exhibition "Wonder Hertz 2016" was organized by the Science Department at Shri Ratanlal Kanwarlal Patni Girls' College on 18-19 November 2016. With this exhibition, we strived to construct a scientific and creative attitude in the young minds. The preparation of the exhibits was an exhilarating experience as it offered ample opportunities for our students to put into practice what they have hitherto learnt only in classrooms. This meant that there are certain things, which cannot be learned by books alone, but need real life experiences.

Faculty members encouraged free pursuit of learning; as a result students developed more than 75 working and non-working models. The exhibition was inaugurated by honorable Chief Guest, Prof. Anil Bhandari, Principal, College of Pharmacy (Laxmangarh), Mr. Subhash Agarwal (Secretary, SRKPGC) and Dr. I.S. Sood (Govt. Nominee and Principal, Govt. College, Kishangarh) on 18 November. We welcomed around 1300 students from 18 government and private schools along with their Head Masters and teachers. They were overwhelmed by the exhibits covering a wide spectrum of topics including- Green Energy, Demonetization, the Genre of Science Fiction, Surgical Strike, Karst Topography, Smart City, Vermicompost, Mathematical Modelling and so on.

On 19 November, Honorable Guest Mr. Bhagirath Chaudhary (MLA, Kishangarh), Mr. Sitaram Sahu (Chairman, Municipal Council, Kishangarh), Mr. Rajkumar Baheti (Vice-Chairman, Municipal Council, Kishangarh), Ms. Shanta Patni (Member, Management Committee), Ms. Jayshree Agarwal (Member, Management Committee), C.A. Sushil Ji and Mr. Pankaj Pahadia (Member, Municipal Council, Kishangarh) graced the event with their presence. They observed all the models and praised the students for their exemplary efforts. The exhibition concluded with the Principal congratulating the staff members and the students for their tremendous hard work.

SRKPGC GETS REGISTERED AT AISHE

Furthermore, in the question-answer session he described different ways to enter this field, such as by pursuing Masters in Social Work, internships, volunteering and lateral entry.



EXTENSION LECTURE ON "HIROSHIMA BOMBING"

Hiroshima Day commemorates 6 August 1945, the day when an atomic bomb was dropped on the Japanese city of Hiroshima. It is now a focus for anti-war and anti-nuclear discussions. The Department of Geography invited an eminent scholar Dr. Ajay Kumar Sharma (Lecturer, SPCGC, Ajmer) as the featured speaker on 6 August 2016. Dr. Sharma spoke about the regret of Einstein on developing such technology, which facilitated the creation of atomic bomb. He also mentioned that India has a significant role in spreading the message of peace and non-violence.

To help students develop and practice business skills, the Department of Management initiated "Business on Campus" activity. Students were given an opportunity to market their products such as handmade trinkets and friendship bands, homemade cakes, pastries and muffins. With this aim, seminar on Career Awareness was organized by Ms. Khyati Jain on 22 and 29 August 2016 for all students. C.A. Mahendra Singh Shekhawat, Inventors Professional Academy, Mumbai, highlighted the trending career opportunities in public and private sectors.

The seminar was followed by a survey to assess the career choices of our girls, which motivated the college to further its endeavors in establishing a guidance academy. Its objective is to provide in-house counseling and coaching for CA-CPT, RAS/ IAS, Bank PO/ Clerk, MBA and other Govt. Exams. A demo class was conducted on 19 December 2016 by IPA on Rajasthan History, Quantitative Analysis and Current Affairs.



STRESS MANAGEMENT TALK

Youngsters experience stress and anxiety during exams, presentations and interviews. To help them cope efficiently with this, a talk on "Stress Management" was organized on 26 August 2016 by Motivational Speaker and Success DNA Activator, Dr. Sanjay Prem. EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO MORARKA FOUNDATION

An industrial visit to Morarka Foundation, Nawalgarh was organized for the students of the Department of Science on 2 October 2016. A total of 40 students visited along with staff members Mr. Vishvajeet Jaroli, Ms. Sakshi Jain and Mr. Lokesh Jain. During the visit, they learnt about the Pisciculture technique, exotic varieties of cucumber, use of solar energy for driving the water pumps and the proper ways of harvesting a crop. The students also had a direct discussion with the General Manager, Mr. Verdhman Bapna and Assistant GM, Mr. Beniwal, and had their queries answered.

INDUSTRIAL VISITS TO R.K. MARBLE FACTORY

Industrial visit to R.K. Marble Factory, a leading producer of marble in the world, was organised for all the students of SRKPGC in batches from 4 October 2016 to 6 October 2016. The students were fortunate to have an interactive session with Mr. Vikas Patni (Director, R.K. Marble) and Mr. Subhash Agarwal (Secretary, SRKPGC). The factory visit started under the guidance of Mr. Virendra Singh Sodha, who began the tour by introducing the students with the legacy and history of the R.K. Marble Group. During the visit the students learnt about the various stages involved in the processing of Indian and imported marbles. The students were also informed about the large varieties of marble stored in the warehouses for export.

VISIT TO A SCHOOL FOR SPECIAL CHILDREN

To sensitise the students about the needs of special children, the Department of Home Science arranged a visit to a school for special children at Chachiyawas (Ajmer) on 6 October 2016. About 41 students participated in this visit and were intensely moved by the vocational training given to the special children for the improvement in their standard of living. Managed by the Rajasthan Mahila Kalyan Mandal Sanstha (RMKM), it aims to improve the lives of rural poor and disabled people.

DIGITAL INDIA WORKSHOP AT MDSU

A one day workshop on Digital India 2016 was organised at the MDS University campus on 20 October 2016. This workshop was organised by the NATIONAL e-GOVERNANCE division under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology. 10 NSS volunteers from SRKPGC also participated in the workshop as Digi-Sevak. The objective of the workshop was to inform the participants about the Digital India Campaign of the Government of India and its major incentives.

Career in the NGO sector seems an appealing option to many youngsters these days. BCA students accompanied by Mr. Ravi Soni, Ms. Anuradha Sharma and Mr. Mrigank Bharadwaj had a pertinent discussion with Mr. Gupta about the serious issues in society.

SARAS DAIRY VISIT

The Department of Science organised one day industrial visit to Saras Dairy, Ajmer on 14 October 2016 for the Biology students under the supervision of Mr. Vishvajeet Jaroli and Ms. Geeta Paliwal. Mrs. Shweta Vyas (Marketing Head, Saras Dairy) provided first hand knowledge to the students about the working of Milk-Plant such as formation of milk committees, milk collection procedure, processing of milk related to various products, quality parameters of milk packaging like percentage of S.N.F. Further, Mr. Ramesh Malik (Dairy Laboratory In-charge) demonstrated the highly precise Milkoscan FT-1 machine which enhanced the overall knowledge on microbiological aspects of dairy processing.

SOCIAL SURVEY AT DHANI PUROHITAN VILLAGE

The Department of Sociology conducted a socio-cultural Field Survey on 6 December 2016 at Dhani Purohitan Village. The students collected data on socio-demographic variables through a structured questionnaire from more than 70 families. Various steps of research methodology were considered before beginning the survey. On the basis of the collected data, they prepared a research report with statistical analysis. The students were benefitted through this field exposure, learning social research and methodology.
